Background on Malta, Today's Celebration & The Maltese American Benevolent Society, Inc.

Malta is a developed European country in the European Union. It is an archipelago that includes inhabited islands of Malta, Gozo and Comino, along with several smaller, uninhabited islands. It is situated in the Mediterranean Sea approximately 60 miles south of Sicily, Italy. Malta is approximately 186 miles with an estimated population of over 545,000 people. Its official languages are Maltese and English and have a long legacy of Roman Catholicism, which continues to be the dominant religion in Malta today.

Throughout history Malta's location in the Mediterranean Sea has given it a strategic importance. Consequently, a sequence of powers including the Phoenicians, Romans, Fatimid's, Sicilians, Knights of St. John, France and British have all conquered the islands. Malta gained independence from the UK in 1964 and became a Republic in 1974. In 2004 it became a member of the European Union.

Malta is known for its world heritage sites, most prominently the Megalithic Temples of Ġgantija (which are the oldest free-standing structures in Europe) and the shipwreck of St. Paul.

After World War I, the Maltese immigration to the US increased with Detroit, Michigan (Corktown) drawing a large share of immigrants due to the expansion of the automobile industry.

The Annual Festa il-Vitorja – Our Lady of Victory

Each September 8th the Maltese gather to celebrate Our Lady of Victory, Maria Bambina. September 8th is the Birth of Our Lady, the Mother of God and is tied to two important dates of victory and rebirth in history. The first victory is known as the Great Siege of 1565. This is where the Ottoman Empire was set out to crush Christianity in Europe and established base in Malta. For five months the island defended the shores and on 8 September 1565 the remaining Turkish army left Malta. Then again during the Second World War, after three years of withstanding bombs from the Italian air force, the Maltese people and British forces defended the islands and the siege was truly lifted on 8 September 1943 when Italy ceded.

The Maltese American Benevolent Society, Inc. of Corktown, Detroit, Michigan

In 1940 the Independence Maltese Club of Detroit, Michigan was established as a place to serve the local Maltese community. Over the years the organization outgrew its location and in 1964 relocated to the current facility at 1832 Michigan Avenue, Detroit, Michiaan under the new name of The Maltese American Benevolent Society, Inc. The organization is a non-profit 501(c)(10) established under the parent organization of NAMA (North American Maltese Association). The organization is run by an eightmember Executive Board comprised of a president, vice president, treasurer, secretary, sergeant at arms and three trustees. Until 2006 the membership was limited to Maltese descendants or their non-Maltese spouses. In 2006 the membership had the foresight to change the Constitution and Bylaws to allow for associate non-Maltese members. While annual membership dues and bar\pastizzi sales are a small portion of the income generated to keep the club's doors open, the sustainability of the organization is largely due to several weekly bingos that generate a large portion of the annual income needed to run the organization.






